

Continuum of LOVE in The Koiné Greek Language

- 1. Erotic base love-*érōs-* (non-biblical)**
- 2. Natural affection - *storgáy* - (only the negative form found twice in The N. T.) Rom. 1:31; 2 Tim. 3:3.**
- 3. Benevolent to humans - *feelahnthrō-paheéah* - Acts 28:2; Tit 3:4.**
- 4. Kindly, naturally affectionate - *feelóhstohr-gohs* - Rom. 12:10.**
- 5. Brotherly kind affection - *feelah-dehlfeéah* - Rom. 12:10; 1 Pet. 1:22.**
- 6. Kind affection, fondness, friendship (n.) *feeléeah* - Jas. 4:4, (v.) *feeléhō* - (can be personal or inanimate - Rev. 22:15) - to befriend, be fond of - Tit. 3:15; Jn 21:17; Mt. 23:6; Lk. 20:46; Jn. 12:25.**
- 7. love - *ahgahpáy* - highest kind of love - the sovereign preference for another over self and others - Jn. 3:16; 13:34; 21:15,16; Gal. 2:20; Eph. 2:4; 1 Jn. 3:10-14.**
